Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) Code of Practice 2014

On 1st September 2014 a new Special Educational Needs Code of Practice was published as part of the 2014 Children and Families Bill.

- Pupils who require additional support to enable them to make good progress in their learning will be registered as receiving 'SEN Support'.
- Children's progress will be reviewed each term and this progress will be shared with parents.
- Children who need individual support will have a Targeted Learning Plan (TLP) to record the support they need.
- Children with more complex needs may receive a co-ordinated assessment of their educational, health and care needs and receive an Education, Health and Care plan (EHC).

- The school will publish an Information Profile identifying how we meet children's additional needs on our website.
- The Local Authority has also published a 'Local Offer' identifying what the LEA provides to meet children's Special Needs. A link to this can be found on the school website alongside the school information profile.
