- Pause the film at 11 minutes and 9 seconds. Draw all the fish you can see.
- Make a picture of your favourite place the Snail visited.

Maths

- Go on a shape hunt around your house. Start with circles, triangles and squares. Write down how many you found of each shape. Which is the largest number?
- Cut up a piece of fruit into 6 pieces. Can you share it equally between you and a grown up? How many pieces did you have each?

- Can you draw the number blocks? Make sure they have the correct number of blocks each.

Can you write some number sentences in your book? $3+1=$
