

A hospital is a place where sick people go to get better. If you are really ill or hurt, and a doctor at your doctors surgery cannot help, you go to hospital. Sometimes people have operations or are given special medicine to help them feel better.

Who works in a hospital?




Doctors and nurses work in a hospital.

When you are staying in a hospital you are given a bed in a **ward**.

There are buttons on the side to make the bed move up and down, which helps the patient to feel more comfortable.

A theatre is the name we call the room where operations are done.

This is a machine that measures people's heartbeats.



This is called an MRI scanner. It takes photos of the inside of people's bodies.
