# Why do people go to the hospital?



A hospital is a place where sick people go to get better. If you are really ill or hurt, and a doctor at your doctors surgery cannot help, you go to hospital. Sometimes people have operations or are given special medicine to help them feel better.



Doctors and nurses work in a hospital. Paramedics work in the ambulances.
