

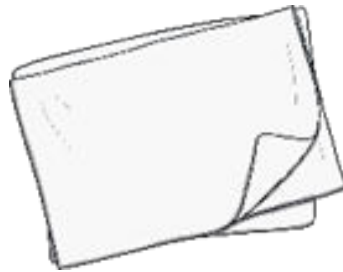
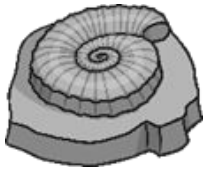
1. I know what is living, dead or never alive.

**never alive** - things that NEVER moved, grew, fed, got rid of waste, created offspring, needed oxygen.




Can you see anything that is **living**, **dead** or **never alive**?





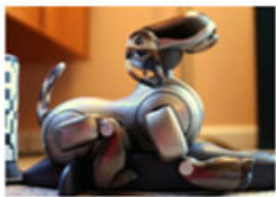
